Application Requirements

In order for a new student to be considered for enrollment, the following <u>must</u> be completed:

- ♦ All Applicants- Preschool, Elementary and Middle School
 - ☐ Submit completed Application for Admission form to SSDHDS
 - □ Submit non-refundable tuition deposit of \$600 per child
 - ☐ Submit a copy of applying student's up-to-date immunization record
- ◆ PS 3 8th grade Applicants
 - ☐ Submit a completed Authorization for Exchange of Information form to SSDHDS Located at www.hebrewday.org- under Admissions, Admission Process, Admissions Forms
 - ☐ Submit all required Recommendation Forms

- ♦ 2nd 8th grade Applicants
 - □ Submit current school's records, including report cards, academic and/or behavioral evaluations, etc

Admissions Policies

Each child is individually evaluated through assessments done at our school as well as from confidential recommendations and transcripts from the previous school. The key determining factors for admission are:

- · Age- the child must be of age on or before September 1st (ie: Kindergartners must be age 5 by September 1, 2019)
- · The child's social, emotional, cognitive and developmental skills
- · The child's academic abilities

Space is very limited in both our preschool and day school. Priority is given to:

- · Siblings of current SSDHDS students
- · Children and siblings of SSDHDS alumni
- Applications submitted by February 1, 2019

Tuition Deposit

A non-refundable tuition deposit of \$600 is due with the submission of each Application for Admission.

Tuition Payment Options 2019-2020

Tuition will be billed in March 2019 for the full 2019-20 school year. First tuition payment is due, with the signed contract, within two weeks of the family receiving their contract. Remaining payment in full, or monthly payments, will begin in June 2019.

Tuition Payment Options

Families may choose to pay tuition in one of three ways:

In Full:

Tuition and fees that are paid directly to SSDHDS in full, in one installment, on or before May 1, 2019 will receive a 3% discount, or on or before June 1, 2019 will receive a 2% discount.

Monthly Payments Through FACTS:

Tuition can be paid monthly, beginning in June 2019, in either 10 or 12 monthly payments, debited from a specified checking or savings accounts through the FACTS Tuition Payment Plan. FACTS charges a \$45 per year, per family, charge for using their service. Families who choose to pay tuition through FACTS must also provide SSDHDS with a current credit card number.

• Monthly Payments with a Credit Card:

Tuition can be paid monthly, beginning in June 2019, in either 10 or 12 monthly payments, charged from a specified credit card that the family provides to the SSDHDS Business office. All payments made by credit card will incur an additional 3.5% convenience fee.

Tuition Policies

Enrollment for the school year may be cancelled by submitting a written cancellation notice prior to June 1, 2019. The initial tuition deposit of \$600, submitted with the Application for Admission, is non-refundable. However, the first tuition payment, made with the return of the signed contract, is refundable, if a written cancellation notice is submitted to SSDHDS by June 1, 2019. If enrollment is canceled after June 1, 2019, the family is obligated to pay the 2019-20 tuition in full.

Each student's enrollment at SSDHDS is contingent upon prompt payment of tuition. If tuition payments are delinquent, the student may be removed from classes and/or dismissed from the school.

Tuition Assistance and the Preschool Jewish Continuity Scholarship

The leadership of our school remains committed to ensuring that the Jewish education at Soille Hebrew Day School is available to every Jewish child, regardless of their family's economic standing. Although it is the responsibility of parents to finance the education of their children, we recognize that some families will need Tuition Assistance or a Scholarship to bring tuition within their means. SSDHDS offers Tuition Assistance to qualifying day school families based strictly on financial need. Additionally, our donors have established the Preschool Jewish Continuity Scholarship to assist preschool families with financial need who are committed to keeping their child(ren) at Soille Hebrew Day school through at least 1st grade. We take great care to ensure that our Tuition Assistance and Scholarship application process is completely confidential. The Finance Committee is comprised of discreet Board members whose decisions are not shared with anyone outside of the committee. The Finance Committee makes a concerted effort to responsibly evaluate each Tuition Assistance and Scholarship application and allocate the limited funds in an equitable manner.

Applying For Tuition Assistance or The Preschool Jewish Continuity Scholarship

In consideration of the 2019-2020 school year, SSDHDS will utilize the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment to conduct a financial need analysis of all Tuition Assistance and Scholarship applications. Families applying for Tuition Assistance or Scholarship will need to complete the online application and submit all the necessary supporting documents to FACTS no later than February 15, 2019. Please be aware that this is a FIRM deadline and that NO Tuition Assistance or Scholarship applications will be accepted after February 15, 2019, with the exception of new families who begin the admissions process after February 15, 2019. As well, please note that as a part of the Tuition Assistance and Scholarship application, families must provide SSDHDS with a current credit report.

Beginning January 15, 2019, families can apply online at http://www.factstuitionaid.com. Once the completed application has been submitted, it will be reviewed by FACTS as well as our own Finance Committee. After reviewing all the pertinent information provided by the parents and FACTS, our Finance Committee will render a decision as to the amount of Tuition Assistance or Scholarship to be offered. Families are notified of their Tuition Assistance or Scholarship award amounts by our Business Manager, Klara Lapp.

SSDHDS cannot guarantee any specific level of Tuition Assistance or Scholarship beyond any single year. Adjustments to Tuition Assistance or Scholarship award amounts from one year to the next can occur because of a change in a family's financial situation and/or adjustments to the school's Tuition Assistance and Scholarship guidelines.
